What is the fifth General Census of Population and Housing (RGPH-2021)?

It is the activity that allows counting and characterizing the entire Cape Verdean and the foreign population that is living or visiting Cape Verde, at a certain time. The RGPH-2021 also allows to georeference and characterize all the buildings, accommodation, and households existing in the country.

What is the importance of conducting the RGPH-2021?

- » The results of RGPH-2021 allow the Government and the Municipal Chambers to have the necessary information to define objectives and priorities in the planning and implementation of public policies, that is, they will allow to identify the needs in terms of schools, hospitals, sanitation infrastructures that the country needs and, thus, improve the quality of life of the population;
- » The data is also important because it allows students (Basic, Secondary, and University) and researchers to carry out academic work, studies, and research.
- » The results make it possible to identify changes related to the number of buildings and the essential characteristics of housing.

Who carries out the RGPH-2021?

The National Statistics Institute is the entity responsible for the collection, processing, and dissemination of statistical information (Decree-Law No. 64/2018 of 20 December).

How will the RGPH-2021 be carried out?

A data collection team, duly identified (with clothes and badges), will visit all households in each area and/or place to conduct interviews with the representatives of the households.

Where will the RGPH-2021 take place?

RGPH-2021 will be carried out in all municipalities, at the level of the smallest administrative division in the country.

When will data collection take place on the ground?

Field data collection will take place between 16 and 30 June 2021.

Who should answer the interview?

The questions must be answered by the household representative. In case of absence, illness, or other impossibility, the questions must be answered by another member of the household who is sufficiently qualified.

Is it mandatory to respond to RGPH-2021?

It is mandatory to provide statistical information, on an unpaid basis, under penalty of sanctions provided for by law. The individual statistical data provided to INE is protected against any illegal disclosure. Article 9, 10, and 41 of Law no. 48 / IX / 2019, of 19 February.
